The August 5th minutes were printed in the newsletter. Janis Voldbakken made a motion to accept the minutes as printed. Martha Fielder seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Kay Ohendalski had the treasurer's report available for review.

Helen Belcher reported that the Executive Board had recommended that annual dues be raised to \$40 per year beginning in January 2020. Members over 70 will pay \$35 per year. The increase is due to the need to generate more income since the guild is no longer having the Airing of the Quilts which was a major fundraiser. A vote was taken and the majority of the membership voted in favor of the increase.

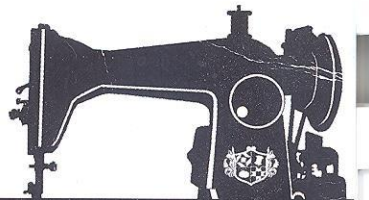

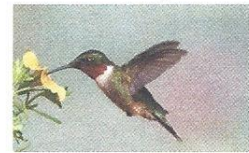
